Evenings on either canal or river are normally suitable for novice paddlers but please ask before joining us on your first sea paddle.

Can we remind members that a licence or membership to British Canoeing is required to paddle on the Basingstoke Canal and River Wey.

If you have neither of these, you will be asked for a £5.00 contribution per paddler towards licencing costs. The Club has purchased a small quantity of licences for ‘Club owned’ boats which will be available to borrow on the specific Club evenings.
